



Donating Products for Export/Re-export Policy

Arthrex Inc. and its subsidiaries (“Arthrex”) may choose to donate products to various benevolent, charitable, not-for-profit, and / or relief organizations for their use to further their respective missions. In some instances, Arthrex or its employees have knowledge that the recipient organization intends to export or re-export the donated products for use or consumption outside the country where the donation occurred. In these cases, it is the policy of Arthrex to require the recipient organization to complete and sign a “Donation Affidavit” in which they agree to accept all responsibility for compliance with any applicable regulations governing such exports, whether imposed by U.S. Government regulatory agencies or, in the case of donations occurring outside of the U.S., by corresponding agencies within the importing country. If the ultimate destination is a country requiring an export license from an agency of the U.S. government, then Arthrex requires proof from the recipient organization it obtained an appropriate export license or license waiver, from the agency and filed all applicable information or documentation timely and in accordance with the requirements necessary to fulfill the conditions of the license.
